

Sunday Service *at* *the* CAPITOL

Sunday March 21, 2010

This Sunday the U.S. House of Representatives is scheduled to be in a rare Sunday Session with votes beginning as early as 1:00 p.m. Accordingly, many members, their spouses, and their staffs plan to assemble in Statuary Hall at 11:00 a.m. for a Sunday service here at the U.S. Capitol. We would like to invite you, your spouse, or your staff to attend.

In 1800, Congress approved the use of the just-completed Capitol structure as a church building, with Divine services to be held each Sunday in the Hall of the House, alternately administered by the House and Senate chaplains. By 1867, the church at the Capitol was the largest church in Washington, DC, with up to 2,000 people a week attending Sunday service in the Hall of the House. This Sunday, we plan to be a part of that history. We hope you can join us.
