1 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS**
2 **FROM ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT OF RETIRED**
3 **PAY AND RETAINER PAY AMOUNTS FOR RE-**
4 **TIRED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES**
5 **UNDER AGE 62.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1401a(b)(4) of title 10,
7 United States Code, as amended by the Bipartisan Budget
8 Act of 2013, is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “except
10 as provided in subparagraph (F),” after “each
11 year,”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following subpara-
13 graph:

14 “(F) EXCEPTION FOR SERVICE-DISABLED
15 VETERANS.—Subparagraph (A) shall not apply
16 to the retired pay of any member or former
17 member who—

18 “(i) is retired under section 1201 of
19 this title;

20 “(ii) is eligible for combat-related spe-
21 cial compensation under section 1413a of
22 this title; or

23 “(iii) is entitled to concurrent pay-
24 ment of retired pay and veterans’ disability
25 compensation under section 1414 of this
26 title.”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) shall take effect immediately after the
3 amendments made to section 1401a of title 10, United
4 States Code, by the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2013 take
5 effect.
